Some Highlights From end of April-July

Dear Friends & Family,

We pray you are all well. We love hearing from you and about all that God is doing in each of your lives. Please drop us a line or two whenever you get a chance. We are thrilled when we receive any news from you personally.

These past few weeks have been great because there was a break in Frank's travel schedule, so he has been home for a few weekends now. These summer months are his busiest time, so Frank is on the road quite a bit. God is doing some awesome things, both here and in the places he travels, and we are thankful for both. Since we last wrote to you (our last paper newsletter) Frank has done training clinics in Bangladesh, KL, and here in Penang. He will be headed to the Philippines next week for another XEE launch and will go to India in August for an Asia leaders retreat. It looks like there is a good possibility that Finn and I will join him in India. There is much to tell you, so Frank will share a couple of highlights from all that has happened over the past two months...



"A team of 10 Malaysians and I went to Bangladesh to lead an XEE launch from April 21-25. This was a strategic event because it was the first time XEE was launched there and most of the 45 participants are key Christian leaders in Bangladesh, a country which is only 0.3% Christian. During my and the team's time there we saw God do amazing things in and through the participants. On the second day of the training I took 3 participants (2 which were pastors) outside the training venue and into the streets of Dhaka, Bangladesh's capital city. It was difficult to navigate the dusty, smoggy, blazing hot streets because of the time of day we were out, and it was Friday which is their holy day or day of rest when everyone heads to their respective place of worship. Amazingly, despite the difficult circumstances, my team and I were able to share with some people on their way to worship and to lead them into a personal relationship with Jesus. I was amazed how God would use our small team to radically change the lives of those we shared with. As of this past month, these former M people are attending church and connecting with other former M people for support as they adjust to a new life of freedom and victory. Even more exciting is the commitment of the Bangladeshi Christian leaders who are wanting to translate and implement the XEE training tool.



A highlight in May was when I went to K.L., Malaysia to lead a 4 day XEE launch for 35 people. The launch was a success due to the commitment of the EE Chairman of Malaysia who said to me upon the close of the clinic, 'Thank you for willingness to assist the EE ministry and churches in Malaysia. We have greatly appreciated your efforts. Our hope for the 2010 year is to wean ourselves from your service and become reliant on our Malaysian Christian leaders to continue the work. Of course we still hope you will encourage us as we champion XEE in Malaysia.'

This may sound like a negative statement, but it actually the biggest compliment for me to receive. My hope and purpose is to try to work myself out of a job, passing the ownership to local leaders in order that it may continue after I leave. For the Chairman to share this with me means that the local national leaders are ready to take the baton and continue to run the race through equipping and reaching the next generation for His Kingdom."

Also Frank, throughout the month of June, coordinated the schedules of and mentored/coached two college-aged interns who came out for a summer cross-cultural internship. He took them to the KL XEE training and then to Cambodia to train others. Among the small group that they trained in Siem Reap, Cambodia there were two tuk-tuk drivers (a "tuk-tuk is a mode of transportation used in Cambodia, which is basically a small motorcycle-driven carriage) who attended. By the end of the training, these two men were very motivated and excited to use this evangelism tool with people they transport around the city, including many tourists visiting from other countries. It was very cool to see the interns in action and these Cambodian guys catch the vision and passion to reach people for Christ in their workplace.



This past week Frank returned from training another group of 16 leaders in KL, Malaysia. The training went very well, and 4 people welcomed Jesus into their lives during visitation. We also had some GREAT friends visit us for a few weeks from Arizona, and they were able to catch the first part of that KL launch as well as to document some of what we are involved in out here. We hope to get a copy to each of you soon via DVD or posted on our website. They were such a tremendous encouragement and breath of fresh air for us, and we are still thanking God for that time of refreshment and rejuvenation.

In other news, on the home-front, Finn is doing well and is a high-spirited fun little boy. We are grateful for God's continued protection and care for Him. We have had to learn a lot about releasing already as we had a bit of a health scare about 3-4 weeks ago. But after running a barrage of tests, everything came back normal and described a healthy one-and-a-half-year-old-boy. We are praising God that nothing abnormal was found, and we are thankful for the ways that He showed up throughout the process. I (Kelly) had an amazing vision, which was a gift from God that brought that peace that passes earthly understanding, of Finn resting on Jesus' chest as he was getting an MRI, and they were both, as well as the big MRI machine, cupped in the hand of God. It was then that I realized ultimately he is in the care of the Almighty God, which is an even better place for him to be than in my arms. Please pray for continued protection and health for Finn as we are planning to travel together as a family to India in August.
