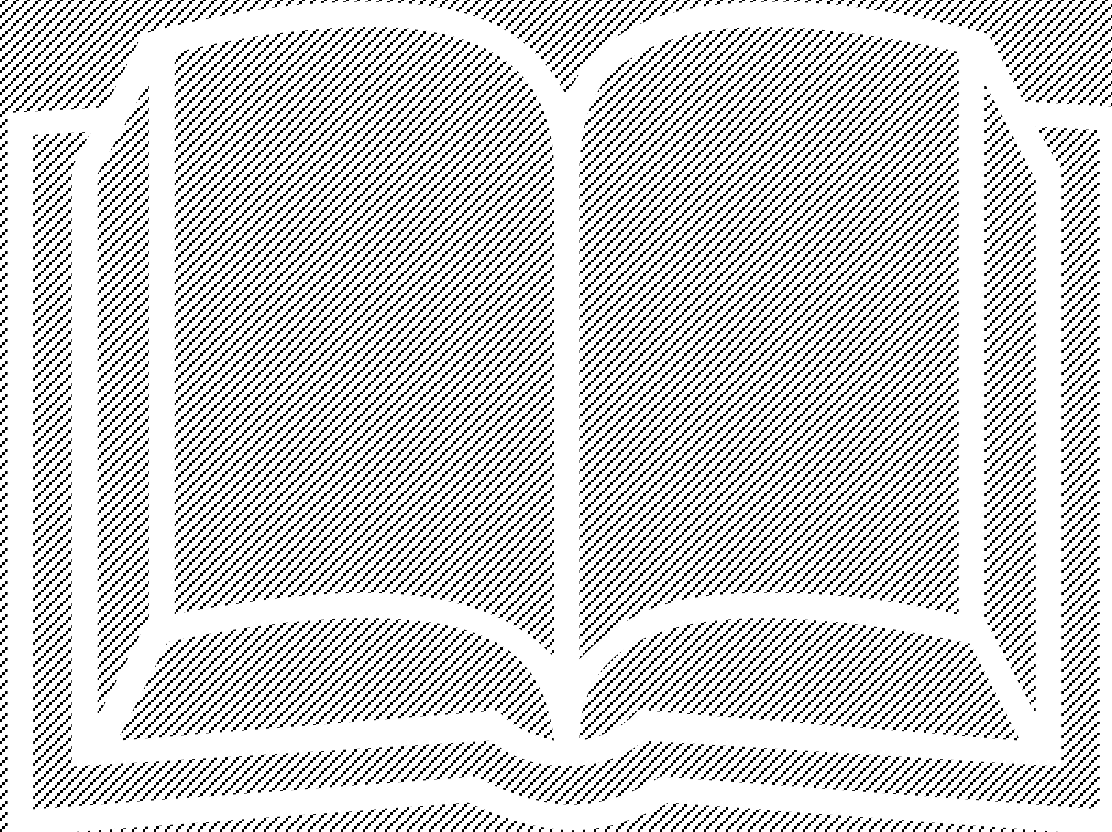

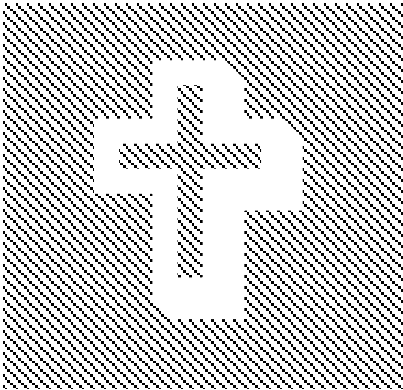

What is your SHAPE to serve? SHAPE is an acronym that helps us understand how we were shaped by God to serve the Body of Christ, the Church.

S= Spiritual Gifts

H= Heart, passion for serving

A= Abilities

P= Personality

E= Experiences that would help in serving others

Each serving opportunity will start with S for spiritual gifts that seem to match the area of service, followed by an H for heart or a passion for this type of service, and ending, for now, with A for abilities that volunteers would find desirable for a successful experience, etc. Of course, our Lord is sovereign and we must be open to His guidance and how He leads us to serve. Finally, as we can't know the future, we do encourage seeking counsel with the ministry leader who can review your SHAPE as it relates to immediate ministry opportunities.
